As you can see from the updated 9/19/2019 Strong R. that was changed and I highlighted it.

Also, I highlighted the other falsity's that Thames entered - like have a problem crack-cocaine, etc. All of this was false and I have not done drugs since 2001, and completed Hope Therapeutic Program in 2007 @ NWCX. Never had any problems since. (axe handle)

After litigation started in Baxter v. TDOC, 10-2667, TDOC started targeting me and accusing me of (1) adulterating a sample, etc., (2) failing for THC, etc. through till litigation was over. It was apparent so several I refused in 2013, 2014. However, these incidents have never been used @ prior parole hearings because they fall off after 18 mths.



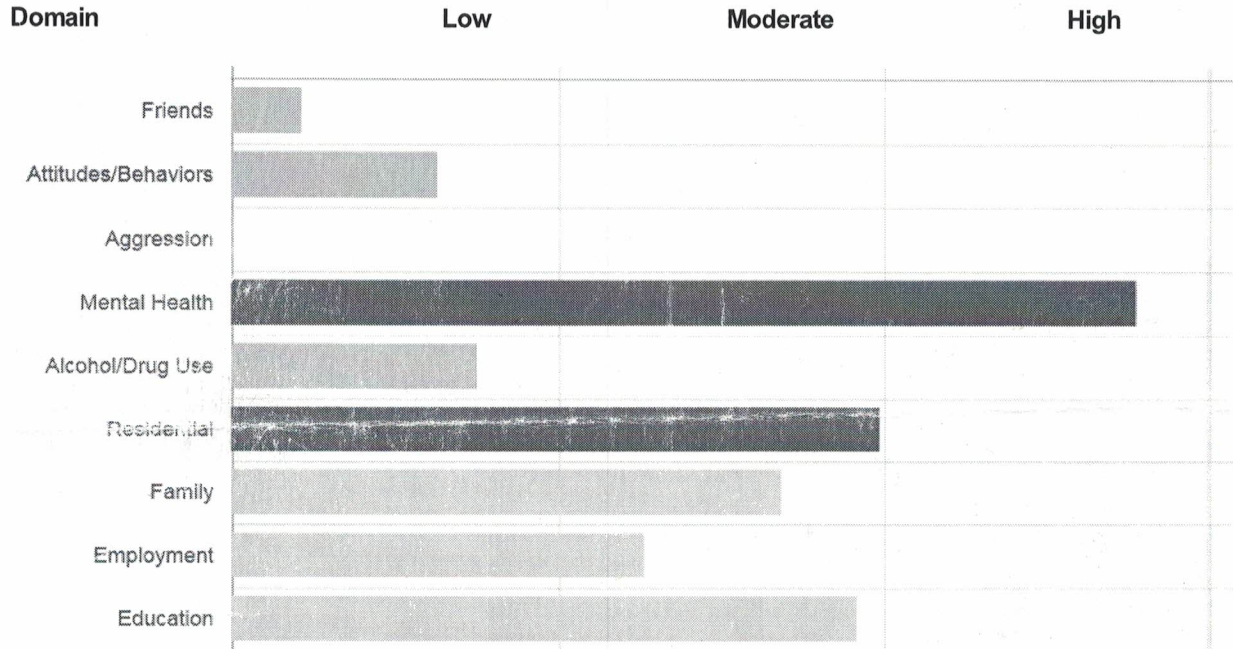
